## The Coin and Die Game

In this game there are two players, Coin and Die. Coin has a coin, and Die has a single six-sided die.

- When it is Coin's turn, he or she flips the coin. If the coin turns up heads, Coin wins the game. If the coin turns up tails, it is Die's turn.
- When it is Die's turn, he or she rolls the die. If the die turns up 1, Die wins. If the die turns up 6, it is Coin's turn. Otherwise, Die rolls again.

Class Exercise. With a partner, play the game 20 times, with Coin going first each time. Keep track of who wins each game, and the total number of coin flips and rolls of the die that takes place in each game.

Then play 20 more games, but with Die going first each time, and keep track of the same information.
